The members of the site council are generally elected by their peers. For example, parents elect the parent representatives and teachers elect teachers.

What the school site council does?

Site councils generally either make decisions or advise the principal and staff on the state allocated school improvement funds and the school's improve-ment plan.

How can parents help with school improvement?

The best way to help your child with improving academic performance is to be involved. The Kolb Elementary School Site Council meets at 3:15 pm on the second Thursday of the month in the library and is open to all parents or community members.
