Developmental Kindergarten Academy (DKA) is the first year of a **two-year kindergarten** experience giving children the gift of time to develop the skills that will prepare them to be successful life long learners.

- What:** DKA is a developmentally appropriate curriculum with a focus on social-emotional readiness. Students learn through play and experiential activities. DKA builds a strong foundation to meet the rigor of kindergarten and solidifies understandings and success for future learning. DKA provides a rich child centered environment that addresses the whole child's social, emotional, physical and academic growth. It is aligned with kindergarten standards and taught by experienced, credentialed teachers. DKA will be followed by 1 year of traditional kindergarten.
- Who:** Any child eligible for Kindergarten enrollment and children who will turn 5 years of age between Nov.2 and Dec. 2, 2012.
- When:** Classes will follow the district calendar with the same hours and class size as kindergarten.
- Where:** School sites to be determined dependant on enrollment.
- How:** Pick up and return your registration packet to your school of attendance. You will then be given an appointment in April for your child to participate in a kindergarten screening assessment and survey. Students are invited to join DKA based on these assessment and survey results.
